Hello Cory and Rob,

Thank you very much for reaching out to Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District (Midpen) for input to the preparation of the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report for the Permanente Creek Restoration Project (PCRP). Please see below for a summary of Midpen projects that could contribute to cumulative conditions in the PCRP area.

- **Project name:** Phased implementation of transportation demand management strategies at Rancho San Antonio (RSA) Open Space Preserve (*Please note that this is a group of multiple future projects. There is no official project name at this time.)
- **Location:** RSA Open Space Preserve and County Park
- **Brief description:** 15 transportation demand management strategies recommended by the Rancho San Antonio Multimodal Access Strategies Report will be implemented by the District in phases over many years. They are expected to encourage visitors to use greener modes of transportation than solo occupant vehicles. They affect cumulative conditions in the vicinity of the Permanente Creek Restoration Project area. For example, there may be a net increase in visitors since the parking demand at the RSA is so great that people will quickly fill up spaces that are vacated by people coming in via another mode. - **Status/Schedule:** These strategies will be implemented in phases over many years. There is no confirmed project plan/ scope/ timeline at this time.

If you have specific questions about the project mentioned above, please do not hesitate to contact us. Additionally, we recommend coordinating with the City of Cupertino, City of Los Altos, and Town of Los Altos Hills for information.

We appreciate the opportunity to submit input and look forward to future coordination with the County and ESA in the next phase of CEQA review for the PCRP.
