Status Update Regarding March 13, 2020 Letter***

Dear Ms. Onciano:

On March 13, 2020, Lehigh Southwest Cement Company provided Santa Clara County with a letter describing the actions that Lehigh took to resolve the June 2019 Notice of Violation. In this letter, Lehigh made reference to the third-party seismic refraction survey conducted at Lehigh's request which verifies the presence and position of a bedrock ridge and corroborates assumptions made in geotechnical analyses presented to the County in 2019. Attached is a March 17, 2020 Stantec memorandum which provides the results of such survey.

Additionally, Lehigh's March 13, 2020 letter included an *Erosion and Sediment Control Plan* which required the repair and/or replacement of BMPs and incorporated the following recommendations by the County's consultant, Michael Baker International:

- **Silt fence fabric has fallen off of the wire mesh backing. The operator should re-tie the silt fencing to the support wire and make any needed repairs to prevent runoff from breaching these sediment control structures.**
- **The BMPs that are no longer performing as intended should be removed because the wire fencing and poles could become a hazard, but care must be taken to not allow the sediment and debris collected behind these structures to move downslope. This material may need to be removed from the slope.**

Attached is a March 24, 2020 confirmatory report prepared by GEI, that confirms that Lehigh has implemented both recommendations for your reference.
