RE: Permanente EMSA Stormwater Monitoring Results – April 2014

Dear Ms. Rush:

The Permanente Quarry samples discharges to Permanente Creek from Pond 30 in the EMSA. Lehigh performed a sampling event for a stormwater discharge from Pond 30 on April 2, 2014. These results are attached.

In these results, only one parameter exceeded a stormwater action level and that was selenium, measured at 29.2 micrograms/liter (ug/L). The action level for selenium is 5.0 ug/L.

Pursuant to the Conditions of Approval of the 2012 Reclamation Plan, Lehigh will investigate and correct any potential sources of selenium in the EMSA drainage area, such as exposed limestone, prior to October 1, 2014.
