

## Alice B. Swain et al to Santa Clara County

 Whereas Alice B. Swain et al being  
 ten or more freeholders of Mt. View Road District, in Santa  
 Clara County, and taxable therein for road purposes did on  
 the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 189<sup>th</sup> petition in writing, the Board of  
 Supervisors of said Santa Clara County to open, establish and  
 maintain a public road in said district; and Whereas, the  
 said Board of Supervisors did thereafter, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April  
 A.D. 1898 acting upon said petition order and declare that a  
 public road be opened, established, located and maintained  
 in said district, to be known as the Permanent road, the  
 description of the center line of said road as declared opened  
 and established as aforesaid being as follows to-wit: Mag.  
 Var. 16° 30' E. Course True. Beginning at a point in the line  
 between the lands of John Snyder and the Alvarez heirs: from  
 which bears T 13, the terminus of the Permanent road. N 48°

 maintenance, we, the undersigned owners, occupants and claimants  
 of lands required for road purposes on the line of the foregoing des-  
 ignated route, hereby signify our approval of the location of said  
 road, and do hereby consent thereto; and we do hereby grant  
 and dedicate the lands belonging to us and each of us,  
 so far as the same may be required for such road, to  
 said County of Santa Clara, to that purpose and for the use  
 of such road, and we do hereby waive all claims for  
 damage for and on account of the same.
