### **Project Location**

The subject property, located at 12411 Merriman Lane, is located adjacent to the existing Thousand Trails RV Park in unincorporated Gilroy.

### **Project Description**

The proposed project is a Major Modification of a Use Permit and Architecture and Site Approval (ASA), and Grading Approval for the expansion of the existing Thousand Trails Recreational Vehicle (RV) Park to include 44 RV spaces on a vacant 7.11-acre parcel (Assessor's Parcel Number: 756-43-024). The proposed project includes a lot line adjustment to combine both properties in order to allow access from Uvas Road. The project also includes the construction of a 1,401 square foot (sq. ft.) restroom with showers and other minor improvements.

#### **Purpose of Notice**

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that the County Planning Staff has recommended that a Mitigated Negative Declaration be approved for this project. County of Santa Clara Planning Staff has reviewed the Initial Study for the project, and based upon substantial evidence in the record, **finds that although the proposed project could initially have a significant effect on the environment, changes or alterations have been incorporated into the project to avoid or reduce impacts to a point where clearly no significant effects will occur.** The project site is not on a list of hazardous material sites as described by Government Code 65962.5 (Cortese List).

A public hearing for the proposed project is tentatively scheduled for the Planning Commission on June 26, 2025 in the County Government Center, 70 W. Hedding Street, San Jose, CA 95110. Where a date is not given, a separate notice will be sent to you informing you of the hearing date. It should be noted that the approval of a Mitigated Negative Declaration does not constitute approval of the project under consideration. The decision to approve or deny the project will be made separately.
