APPLICATION REVIEW

The Entertainment Event and Circus License application is missing the following required information (see Sec. B3-113 of the County Ordinance):

- A financial statement of the promoter or sponsor sufficient to show the financial ability to meet any conditions of the license.

Please see attached bank statement from one member.

- A detailed description of how persons exceeding the attendance estimate will be accommodated

In case if we have exceeded no. of attendance, we will manage by rotating people in and out such as holding the folks outside and wait until the folks inside the property leaves then allow them to come in.

- A description of how the total number of persons actually attending the circus or entertainment event will be determined.

As we plan, as the folks come in we will account the no. of attendees. In addition, the folks will come to our parking lot at 282 Vista ave. we will drive them to our the 4198 gion ave. during this time, we will count the no. of folks to keep track.

- The location and capacity of the parking areas and the means of controlling traffic flow into, within and out of the parking areas. *Include proof of ownership or permission from owner for the property designated for parking*

- there will be volunteers who will be in charge of letting people in and making sure the cars are orderly coming, parked orderly, and leave orderly.

- A map or diagram of the means of access to the performance area. (see map no.

- A detailed description of the proposed lighting, including location of all light standards and electrical switches.

-The event is taking place outdoor so no lighting is required. Please see map.

- A certificate evidencing a public liability and property damage insurance policy issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in California naming the County of Santa Clara as co-insured and in an amount sufficient to cover any liability or damages that might arise from the event.

-please see attached insurance policies

Please note that pursuant to Sec. B3-113, an application is to be filed 90 days prior to the commencement of the event. The Zoning Administrator can reduce this time in some cases, but not always. Some license applications require a public hearing.
