- 1. Page 1 of the submitted application package states that 123 trees are proposed to be removed, while page 4 indicates 113 trees are proposed to be removed. Please clarify which number is correct.
- 2. Page 5 of the submitted application package states that three trees are to be replaced (1 @ 3:1 ratio). Please clarify if the proposal is to replace one tree following tree replacement ratios and pay in-lieu fees for all other protected trees for which tree replacement is required, or if a different combination of tree replacement and in-lieu fees is proposed. Specify which removed trees are proposed to be replaced, if any. Note that pursuant to County Ordinance Section C16-3, on property owned/leased by the County, protected trees are those which measure over 37.7 inches in circumference (12 inches or more in diameter) measured 4.5 feet above the ground, or which exceed 20 feet in height. For each protected tree above 5 inches DBH removed, either replacement trees must be planted or in-lieu fees must be paid.
