- 1. Please provide each form/document as a separate pdf.
- 2. Note that many comments that were provided in the pre-screening for this application, PLN24-003-PRE, were not addressed in this submission. All comments must be addressed for review of this application.
- 3. Please note that the proposed grading must meet all findings in County Ordinance Section C12-433 to receive Grading Approval. The Grading Justification Statement provided on page 14 of the file titled "RICAVISTA_SUBMISSION" does not detail how the proposed grading meets each finding. Staff recommends this be revised to do so.
- 4. Obtain permission from PG&E to perform work over the 10' wide easement on the property. Provide evidence of this in the form of a letter or other documentation.
- 5. Clearly label the limits of proposed grading. Provide additional sheets that show the pre-

violation conditions of the site and clearly identify the boundaries of the unpermitted grading. Demonstrate that the proposed grading fully abates the unpermitted grading to pre-violation conditions.

- 6. Revise the grading quantities information to provide violation cut, fill, and height quantities, and currently proposed cut, fill, and height quantities. Clarify how much material, if any, is being proposed to be completely removed from the site.
- 7. The sheets in the provided civil plans do not appear to be numbered correctly, as two sheets are labeled "Sheet 2 of 3", and there are four total sheets. Please revise as necessary.
- 8. The third sheet of the civil plans appears to have missing details along the left side of the page; please revise as necessary.
