**Application Documents** 

- 1. The application is incomplete because it does not contain all application documents required by the <u>Miscellaneous Planning Submittal Checklist</u>. For the resubmittal, provide the following application documents:
  - a. Master Planning Application Submit a completed Master Planning Application signed by the property owner or authorized member of the LLC; and
  - b. Removal description Provide a description of the method to be used in the removal of the tree.
- 2. The application is incomplete because it includes tentative locations for tree replacement, but does not include a tree replacement plan, as required by the Miscellaneous Planning Submittal Checklist. Submit a tree replacement plan that ascertains the species, size, and location of the replacement trees relative to the proposed development and throughout the property. Oak trees must be replaced with oak trees. Note that the location of the replacement trees must be selected to be in a feasible area to promote proper growth and longevity of the replacement trees.

Example: Locating trees immediately adjacent to existing trees, septic tanks, leech fields, wells, retaining walls, structural foundations, and driveways should be avoided.

Replacement trees will be required in accordance with <u>Santa Clara County Guidelines for Tree Protection and Preservation for Land Use Applications</u>. Replacement trees shall be of a like-kind species of the tree removed, and the following are the replacement ratios:

For the removal of one small oak tree (5 - 18 inches):

Three 15-gallon oak trees, or two 24-inch oak box trees

For the removal of one medium oak tree (18 - 24 inches):

Four 15-gallon oak trees, or three 24-inch oak box trees

For the removal of an oak tree larger than 24-inches:

Five 15-gallon oak trees, or four 24-inch oak box trees

For the resubmittal, provide a tree replacement plan that incorporates replacement oak trees in accordance with above tree replacement ratios.
