My husband and I recently purchased a property on Crescent Road in the Town of Los Gatos. We also live on a dead-end road exceeding a length of 800 feet in the VHFHSZ. For all the reasons outlined in the home owners' appeals we support the approval of their projects.

We have been told by Edith Hannigan of the BOF that ONLY the Town/City/County has the authority to approve or deny a planning permit. CAL FIRE's recommendations are just that - recommendations. These Regulations, which are currently in draft mode, were never intended to apply to existing roads as evidenced by the latest draft version published by the Board of Forestry and Fire Protection.

We urge the Fire Marshall to approve these projects without further delay.
